 Veterans & Family Support, Buddy Poppy/VFW National Home, Hospital and Legislative by March 31, 2026
 - ★ I hope that your Auxiliary would choose to work all Auxiliary Programs, our program reporting year runs from 4/1/25–3/31/26, all reports must be completed by 3/31/26
- Your Auxiliary Officers: President, Secretary and Treasurer must have their Dues paid NO later than December 15, 2025. All other Officers paid by 12/31/25
- 6. Your Auxiliary must obtain at least 98% in Current Membership by May 15, 2026, and you must have Recruited the following number of New Annual, New Life, or Rejoined Members based on your total Membership as of 6/30/2025.
