Seek out local groups and organizations in need of assistance Ask what your Auxiliary can do to partner with them Vote on your Auxiliary floor to accept the challenge to volunteer Execute the partnership Record the details and report your success

Now is Prime Time for Auxiliary Outreach, with the government shutdown and the holidays fast approaching some community members will need assistance with food insecurity, funds for upcoming holidays or coats for the winter weather.

Here are some ideas on ways your Auxiliary can partner with local groups and organizations:

- Help food banks/pantries with collecting donations by going door-to-door or setting up a collection point at the local grocery store. Assist with sorting food donations, stocking shelves, or handing out commodities.
- Assist organizations/churches with community meals.
- Assist other organizations with community wide winter coat and clothing drive.
- Assist with community toy drives for Christmas.
- Volunteer to ring the bells for the Salvation Army during the holiday season.
