This month I'm going to introduce our 2023-2024 Buddy Poppy/National Home Ambassador Lisa Jackson and let her explain the changes in our programs.

Our poppies are now being made in Kansas City by a group of disabled individuals that work for Cottonwood Inc. These individuals can make an authentic poppy. With the help of Cottonwood Inc, VFW can ship poppies out within three days. Unfortunately, the cost of our poppy's has doubled in price. With the cost increase, VFW has investigated finding new forms of poppies at a lower price. They have found a metal poppy that will be able to be purchased from the VFW store. The price is still being determined and more information will be available in September.

The VFW National Home has also gone through some changes. Did you notice I did not say the "VFW National Home for Children?" They have dropped the "for Children" and will now be known as the VFW National Home. This was the original name when the National Home was first started. They are centering on

the needs of the military, veterans and their families. They have also changed their logo. They kept the "three hearts tree" ands removed the box that was around it.
