Veterans Voices Writing Project (VVWP) originally began as the Hospitalized Veterans Writing Project (HVWP), an outreach program for wounded veterans returning from World War II. Volunteers went into Department of Veterans Affairs hospital wards to encourage soldiers and sailors to write their stories, thoughts and feelings on paper. They also worked by correspondence with veterans once they left the hospital. Today, the project continues to actively encourage all military veterans to express their thoughts and feelings in writing and to send their stories, poems, and essays to the VVWP headquarters for possible publication in Veterans' Voices. The ranks of World War II veterans have thinned, but there is no shortage of veterans from other wars in need of an outlet for their writing and the Veterans Voices Writing project is there to serve them.
