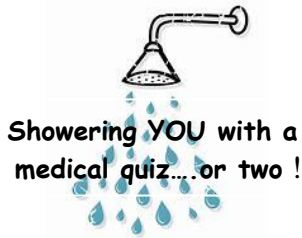
BACKSIDE: the rear or back part or view of an object, person, scene, etc.; that part which is opposite the front.
