All of the VFW-endorsed bills from the 117th session of Congress expired on January 3, 2023, when the new session started. Keep an eye on the **VFW Action Center** to see which new bills they endorse at *votervoice.net/VFW/bills*.

The VFW 2023 Priority Goals are now on display and they are as follows:

Budget; Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs; Education, Employment and Transition Assistance; Health Care; Military Quality of Life; and National Security, Foreign Affairs, and POW/MIA.

The VFW will continue to work diligently to ensure members of the newly seated Congress improve care and benefits for veterans, service members and their families.

The new session of Congress opens with 97 members who have military experience, **the most since 2015!**

Topeka has been announced as a new site for a **proposed new veterans home** to be built adjacent to the Colmery-O'Neal U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center. This home would include 72 private rooms, divided into "households" and "neighborhoods" for the purpose of increasing community between residents.

The Topeka area is home of many of our nation's heroes, and the new veterans home will strengthen an already-strong veteran community. Veterans will have close access to quality VA healthcare and resources.
