

We just made it back from our 111th VFW Auxiliary National Convention held in Louisville, KY. We have come so far over the last 100 Plus Years in this Great Organization. The Veterans of Foreign Wars Ladies Auxiliary started with a small group of women who wanted to serve Veterans. In 2015, we were able to grow our Organization when the name changed from VFW Ladies Auxiliary to VFW Auxiliary and male members were added. Change came again in 2021, when it was voted during the National Convention to remove the verbiage pertaining to being a US Citizen as a requirement for membership.

There are 12 Individuals who are able to join the VFW Auxiliary under one qualified Veteran. Not every potential member that we approach will be eligible. Acceptable proofs of eligibility include DD-214 separation documentation, records from a memorial or website showing eligibility, the Wall of Faces (www.vvmf.org/Wall-of-Faces) VFW Eligibility full List (www.vfw.org/join/eligibility) An Investigating Committee of 3 should be formed to review the eligible Veterans DD-214 and the completed Membership Application, and the signatures of at least 2 persons who served on this committee are necessary. Please review the VFW Auxiliary Membership Moment How to Ensure a Membership Application is Complete.

There are several resources available on the Department of KS Website <u>vfwauxks.org</u>—go to Programs and click on Membership. This year we are encouraged to make use of the QR Code that National has created for us. It will take you to the National Website and on it you will find the latest Fact Sheet, Membership Application and Membership Brochure.

We must **include every member** in what we're doing. <u>Not every member that joins will attend meetings</u>. It's important that we get to know our members and find out what their strengths are. Ask them to participate in our Programs and have a **Member Spotlight** throughout this year. Let's make sure that members within your community know what the individuals have done for this organization and our Veterans.

Our Membership Goals this year will be published in my Membership Sunflower Express Articles. Keep your eyes out for them. Our First Membership Challenge was to Host a Membership Drive/Requirement Event. This could be at any point in the Year and the Logistics are set on how your District Membership Chairman wishes.
