Brothers and Sisters,

Wow, it's already October! There are two VFW contests that you may assist with on judging. Some Districts are asking for a photo of the student when you send your 1<sup>st</sup> place entry to them. So maybe talk to your VFW and VFW Auxiliary District Chairmen.

#### Patriot's Pen

Theme for 2024-2025 is "**My Voice in America's Democracy**" Patriot's Pen is open to 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades. All essays will be typed in English with no color or graphics and 300 – 400 words in length. The essay must be students original work and a product of the students own thinking. The approach to the theme should be positive and clearly focused. Poetry is not accepted. The body of the essay must not identify you in anyway. Quotations may be used sparingly if plainly identified whenever used.

Judging Criteria:

Knowledge of theme is worth 30 points. Did the student show they had knowledge of the theme? Does it sound like they researched the issue?

Theme development is worth 35 points.

Has the student answered all relevant facts who, what, where, when and why? Are they able to relate with their own experiences?

Clarity of ideas is worth 35 points.

Is it easy to understand the format? Does the essay leave a clear understanding of the explanation of the theme?

### Voice of Democracy Audio – Essay Contest

Theme for 2024-2025 is "**Is America Today Our Forefathers**' **Vision**?" Open to students in grades 9-12. Students record their original 3 – 5 minute (+ or – 5 second max) audio essay on a flash drive, or other electronic device. Also with the recording, a typed essay of the speech and completed entry form. In addition, you can submit your emailed entry form, essay, and audio file to the VFW Post upon approval. The recording must be in your own voice and in English. No music, singing, poetry or sound effects are allowed. The body of the essay must not identity you in anyway.

Judging Criteria:

Originality is worth 30 points. Does the essay show imagination and human interest?

Content is worth 35 points. Are ideas clearly expressed and organized? Is the theme fully developed and transitions used to move smoothly from one idea to another?

Delivery is worth 35 points. Did they speak clearly and in a credible manner?

### **Contest Eligibility**

- Student does not have to be related to a VFW or VFW Auxiliary member to participate
- Students in grades 9-12 by March 31 deadline who are enrolled in a public, private, parochial or home school program in the United States, its territories and possessions, or dependents of U.S. military or civilian personnel in overseas schools.
- Although U.S. citizenship is not required, students must be lawful U.S. permanent residents or have applied for permanent resident (the application for which has not been denied) and intends to become a U.S. citizen.
- Foreign exchange students, students aged 20 or older, GED and adult education students are **not** eligible.
- Previous winners of VFW Auxiliary National 3-Dimensional Patriotic Art Contests are **not** eligible.

### **Contest Rules**

- Entry must be completed during the current school year.
- Entry must be three dimensional.
- Entry may not be larger than 18"in any direction
- Entry may not weigh more than 5 pounds.
- Stone, clay, metal, wood, fabric, papier mâché, pottery, and other media may be used.
- Digital art and photography, weapons, art generated by a 3-D printer and jewelry are **not** accepted.
- If the American Flag is used, it must conform to the Federal Flag Code in relation to colors, numbers of stars and stripes and other pertinent rules of the code.
- Completed typed or printed legible entry form including student and parent and/or guardian signatures.
- Typed or printed legible explanation of the steps taken to create the 3-Dimensional art entry and artist statement (250 words or less).
- Submit at least 2 photos of completed art entry

- May 5: First place winner from each Department (state) due to VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters for judging.
- **July/August:** All students will be notified of entry status via email provided on entry form. First through third place winning entries will be announced on VFW Auxiliary National social media pages and may be displayed at the VFW Auxiliary National Convention.
- **September:** All art entries received at VFW Auxiliary National will be returned to students to the address provided on the entry form.

### **Contest Eligibility**

- Students in grades 9-12 by March 31 deadline who are enrolled in a public, private, parochial or home school
  program in the United States, its territories and possessions, or dependents of U.S. military or civilian personnel in
  overseas schools.
- Although U.S. citizenship is not required, students must be lawful U.S. permanent residents or have applied for permanent resident (the application for which has not been denied) and intends to become a U.S. citizen.
- Foreign exchange students, students aged 20 or older, GED and adult education students are **not** eligible.

### **Contest Rules**

- Entry must be completed during the current school year.
- Entry must be two dimensional.
- Entry must be on canvas or paper.
- Canvas entries must be submitted on a stretcher frame or canvas board.
- Paper entries must be reinforced with heavy paper.
- Do not frame art with wood, metal, plastic or glass.
- Mats may be used, including mounted and floating mats.
- Entries may not be smaller than 8"x10" and not larger than 18"x24" including mat.
- Acrylic, chalk, charcoal, crayon, graphite, ink, marker, oil, pastel, pen, pencil, tempera, watercolor or other media may be used.
- If the American Flag is used, it must conform to the Federal Flag Code in relation to colors, numbers of stars and stripes and other pertinent rules of the code.
- Digital art and photography are **not** accepted.
- Completed typed or printed legible entry form including student and parent and/or guardian signatures.
- Typed or printed legible artist statement (250 words or less).
- Student name on back of art entry.
