Completed form and pictures is due is March 31, 2025 to me. I will then select the best entry and send on to our National Ambassador Dina Hudson.

Young American Creative Patriotic Art is for graes 9-12 who have a passion for art. Art is judged on patriotic theme and technique. Art may be on canvas or paper. Canvas entries must be on a stretcher frame or canvas board. Paper entries must be reinforced with heavy paper. Mats may be used on paper entries, including mounted or floating mats. Entries may not be smaller than 8"X10" and not larger than 18"X24" including mat. Acrylic, chalk, charcoal, crayon, graphite, ink, marker, oil, pastel, pen, pencil, tempers, watercolor or other media may be used. If using the American Flag, it must conform to the Federal Flag Code. Digital art and photography are not accepted. Completed typed or printed legible entry form including student and parent or gauardian signatures. Typed and printed statement (250 words or less) artist statement. Student must have name on back of art entry. National Prizes range from \$500 - \$15,000. Entry is due to VFW Auxiliary March 31, 2025. Please make sure you are using the revised September 2024 application.

<u>3-Dimensional Patriotic Art</u> is for grades 9-12. Entry may **not** be larger than 18" in any direction and weigh no more than 5 pounds. Stone, clay, metal, fabric, paper mache, pottery, and other media may be used. Digital art and photography, weapons, art generated by a 3-D printer and jewelry are **not** accepted. Please use the Federal Flag Code if using the American Flag. Completed typed or printed legible entry form including student and parent or gaurdian signatures. Typed explanation of steps taken to create the 3-Dimensional art entry and artist statement (250 words or less). Submit at least two photos of completed art entry. National awards range from \$500-\$2,500. Entries are due March 31, 2025 to VFW Auxiliaries. **Please make sure you are using the revised September 2024 application.**

Please have your 1st place art work to me by April 15, 2025.
