 - Citation and \$25 to one VFW Auxiliary in each of the 10 Program Divisions that hosts the most outstanding activity and/or event to celebrate/assist service members and/or veterans in the community.

There are many ways we can accomplish the goal to assist our veterans. A few are:

- Making sure that EVERY veteran knows the Veterans Crisis Line number. **988, press 1**Get the information out (newspaper, newsletter, posters in the Post, <u>purchase one of the Department's Joint Project PTSD Awareness T-shirts and wear it!)</u>
 - Adopt a Unit. This is such an easy way to directly assist our current service members (and their families). See the Adopt-A-Unit FAQ under the Veterans & Family Support Program on our Department website, or give me a call/text/email for more suggestions not listed there on ways to show your support.
 - Remember to support their families, they've made sacrifices too. Veterans need to know their families will be taken care of.
 - Most importantly: listen. The best way to know their needs is to hear what those needs are. And don't be afraid to ask how we can help.

Also, just a reminder that August 7th is the date that we observe National Purple Heart Day. It's a time to remember and honor the brave men and women who were either wounded on the battlefield or paid the ultimate sacrifice with their lives. If you know a surviving Purple Heart recipient, take the time to acknowledge them.
