As members of the VFW Auxiliary, it is our duty to ensure that our veterans and their family members are aware of the aid and services available to them in times of need.

The Veterans & Military Support Program contains the following:

- 1. Military Assistance Program, commonly referred to as MAP
 - a. MAP provides financial assistance to Posts, Districts, and Departments to sponsor morale-boosting send offs, homecomings, and casual get togethers. Those Posts or Auxiliaries that participate in Adopt-A Unit and Family Readiness Group events can also receive assistance. - 2. Unmet Needs
 - a. Grants are available up to \$1,500.00 payable to a creditor to help bridge the gap to make a mortgage payment, fix a car, make unexpected home repairs, etc., when a soldier is serving on foreign soil and unable to make it back home or simply cannot afford to make the necessary repair.
- 3. VFW Sports Clips Help a Hero Scholarship Program
 - a. Sports Clip Help a Hero Scholarship awards scholarships up to \$5,000 to qualifying veterans and service members to help them complete their educational goals.
