NATIONAL VETERAN AND MILITARY SUICIDE PREVENTION

Confidential support is available 24 hours a day/7days a week, 365 days a year. Support for deaf and hearing impaired individuals is available. TIP: Add the Veterans Crisis Line number in your cell phone for easy referral.

CHILD CARE FOR ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE MEMBERS

- Provide babysitting for a few hours each week
- Provide diapers and wipes for babies and toddlers

This special focus is on those veteran's families that are trying to support themselves and their children

VETERANS AND MILITARY SUPPORT PROGRAMS

- 1. National Veterans Service (NVS)
 - NVS is a nationwide network of nearly 300 VFW Service Officers who help veterans and their families navigate the VA system. They help with disability compensation, rehab and educational programs, pension and death benefits, employment and training and quality health care.

- 2. Military Assistance Program (MAP Funds)

MAP helps VFW and Auxiliary members give more to their local military units by providing financial assistance for moral boosting, send offs, homecomings, and get togethers. If you choose to participate in Adopt-A-Unit, MAP can help. It also keeps the care packages circulating by covering the postage.

3. Unmet Needs

Unmet Needs provides grants up to \$1,500.00 to bridge the gap to make a mortgage payment, rent, home repairs, car repairs, utility costs, food and clothing in a crisis

- 4. Sports Clips
 - Help a Hero Scholarship
 - 1. Awards up to \$5,000 to qualifying veterans or service members to help complete their educational goals.

Entry form is required and available in MALTA Member Resources. VFW Auxiliaries must send the required entry form to their Department Veterans & Family Support Chairman by March

31, 2025 for judging. The Department Veterans & Family Support Chairman must sign and send a copy of the completed Department-winning entry form to the National Veterans & Family Support Ambassador by April 30, 2025 for judging.

Citations will be mailed directly to the winning VFW Auxiliaries from National Headquarters and money will be deposited into the winning VFW Auxiliary account after the 2025 VFW Auxiliary National Convention.

Shaving Cream


Hand Sanitizer
