Who they are: After 911 founder Carolyn Blashek began volunteering at the Los Angeles airport military lounge. In March 2003, a soldier came into the office and broke down at her desk. He was on leave from a war zone for his mother's funeral, his wife had left him, and his only child had died as an infant- he had no one else in his life. "I'm going back over there; I know I won't make it back this time, but it really doesn't matter because no one would even care." he told her. Right then, Blashek realized that when bullets are flying, troops must believe that someone at home cares about them as an individual. That's when Operation Gratitude was born, with four care packages shipped to deployed service members in Iraq. Since its inception, the organization has encouraged Americans across the country to express their gratitude and lift the spirits of millions of deployed troops, recruit graduates, veterans, military families, and first responders.

Besides care packages, this company also provides their traditional "Battalion Buddy" bears for children of deployed service members. Each bear wears tags that say, I'm your Battalion Buddy and I'm here to keep you company while your Mom or Dad is away. I'm excited to join your family.
